# Crown Trophy Home Run Derby 

## Participant Eligibility:

- $8 u-9 u-3$ players per team
- 10u-12u-2 players per team


## Field Dimensions:

- Fence Distance shall be as follows: $8 \mathrm{u}-: 140^{\prime}\left|9 \mathrm{u}-10 \mathrm{u}: 150^{\prime}\right| 11 \mathrm{u}-12 \mathrm{u}: 190^{\prime}$ (distance is to CF)

Pitchers:

- All batters must provide their own pitcher.
- All pitchers must be 18 years of age or older.
- All pitchers must be positioned and pitching from behind an L-Screen, which is positioned $30^{\prime}$ from plate.
- All pitchers must throw over handed-no side arm or under hand throwing permitted.


## Bats \& Helmets:

- All bats must follow the Premier Sporting Events rulebook.
- All participants must wear a helmet.


## 1st Round:

- All participants receive 1:30 to hit as many home runs as possible.
- Any baseball hit over the fence in fair territory is a home run.
- At the end of round 1, the top 10 participants per division with the most home runs will advance to the 2 nd round (if event has less than 10 participants, all participants will advance to 2 nd round).


## 2nd Round:

- The 10 participants receive 1:30 to hit as many home runs as possible.
- Batting order will be determined by number of home runs hit in the first round with the lowest total number hitting first.
- Any baseball hit over the fence in fair territory is a home run.
- At the end of round 2 , the top 5 participants per division with the most home runs will advance to the championship round (if event has less than 10 participants, all participants will advance to championship round).


## Championship Round:

- All 5 participants receive 1:30 to hit as many home runs as possible.
- Batting order will be determined by total home runs hit in 1 st and 2 nd rounds with the lowest total number hitting first.
- Any baseball hit over the fence in fair territory is a home run.
- At the end of the Championship Round, the batter with the most home runs hit during this round is the Henrico Baseball Classic Home Run King.
- If a tie exists at the end of the Championship Round, we will total the total number of home runs the player hit in all 3 rounds with the most hit becoming the Henrico Baseball Classic Home Run King.
